## High School Level 1 & Level 2: SPRING & FALL Semester Lessons

The primary objective for high school students is to develop the skills needed to enhance their understanding of the Quran through reflection. Students will undertake a thematic study to learn how to connect with the Quran by analyzing its background, context, and meaning (translation), and by applying the lessons learned from selected chapters and verses in relation to the topics covered in our curriculum as below:

- Faith and Belief - Pillars of Iman
- Fiqh & Practices - Pillars of Islam
- Conducts & Islamic values
- Prophets Life, Legacy - Seerah & Hadiths
- Legacy of Prophets & Messengers
- Contemporary Issues in light of Islam

Students engage in a thematic study of the Quran to develop a deeper, more personal connection with the text. This approach empowers them to confidently consult the Quran through English translations and accompanying explanations, enabling them to seek both understanding and guidance from its teachings.

By the end of this class, students will recognize the vast treasure of knowledge and wisdom within the revelation, enabling its message to shape their understanding and guide their actions and guide their personal growth, choices and contributions.
