1 Islamic Studies Program (KG – Grade 12)

Overview: The Islamic Studies program spans Kindergarten through Grade 12, utilizing grade-level textbooks from Weekend Learning Publisher. Each core theme is introduced in early grades and progressively deepened over successive years to match students' growing cognitive understanding, emotional maturity, and spiritual development.

Core Themes

● Faith & Belief	Foundations of the Pillars of Iman, Tawhid, and Allah's Attributes.
