

Hifz Program restructuring and enhancements.

Program Objectives

- Memorize the entire Qur'an with accuracy (Tajweed and pronunciation).
- Build strong revision habits to ensure retention.
- Memorize 1 page per day consistently.
- Review half of the Juza per day to retain what is already memorized.
- Complete memorization of the Qur'an in 3 years.
- Recite memorized portions with zero or minor mistakes

Daily Routine Structure and Timing:

Full time Hifz is from 8:00AM- 3:00PM.

Daily Hifz Program Structure

8:15 AM – 9:15 AM

Morning Session – New Memorization

- Memorize **one page** daily.
- The student will repeat the page **7–10 times** under the supervision of the teacher.

9:25 AM – 11:00 AM

Revision Session – Previous Hifz

- Revise **half a Juz** from previously memorized portions.
- The teacher will actively supervise to ensure **accuracy, fluency, and continuity**.

11:00 AM – 11:30 AM

Break and Lunch

11:30 AM – 1:00 PM

Daily Page Finalization

- Finalize the memorization of the assigned daily page with **minimal errors**.

- **No homework** will be assigned. The student should complete all Hifz work during school hours.
- **Parents are not responsible** for overseeing Hifz at home, as the student receives sufficient time and instruction with the full-time teacher.

1:45 PM – 2:45 PM

Wrap-Up Session

- Finalize both the **assigned page** and the **revision** for the day.
- Once again, **no homework** will be assigned, as students may have other responsibilities, such as online schooling.

Qur'an Hifz Program Placement Test Rules:

Purpose of the Test

- Determine the student's starting point in the Hifz curriculum.
- Assess the level of memorization fluency and Tajweed knowledge.
- Classify students into Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced levels.
- Identify areas of weakness (consistency, accuracy, retention).

Conditions for Hifz Program Admission

- Age Requirement usually 7 years and above.
- Younger children may be accepted if they demonstrate strong reading fluency and discipline.
- Qur'an Reading Proficiency:
- Student Must be able to read the Qur'an fluently with basic Tajweed.
- Pre-Hifz students may need to complete a Qur'an reading course first.
- Must have memorized a minimum of Juz 'Amma (Juz 30).
- Students must pass the placement test.
- Students must be self-motivated and able to commit to long-term memorization and the daily structured timing.

Scholarships and discounted tuitions

- The community members are invited to sponsor a Hafiz, with the goal of completing the memorization of the entire Qur'an within three years.

- Scholarships or discounted tuition may be offered to outstanding students or those with limited financial means.
